The Henegar Center Summer Theatre Workshop is looking for **Camp Counselors** and **Theatre Interns** for our exciting Summer Shows, “A Year with Frog and Toad Kids” and “The Lion King Experience Jr.”! To apply you must be entering your Sophomore year of High School through College Seniors. Interviews will be conducted at the end of May. Please include a resume and a letter of recommendation from a teacher or work supervisor. Applications are due **Friday, May 19**. College students will serve as **Theatre Interns** and will receive a weekly stipend. High School students will serve as **Counselors** and will receive free tuition to the High School Workshop.

We are seeking motivated individuals to come on board in leadership roles serving as student interns. This experience rounds out college applications and resumes and is a perfect way to explore a possible career in the arts. Interns receive hands-on theatrical training from our skilled staff and are expected to serve in leadership positions.

Summer Programming meets Monday-Friday starting June 5th. The elementary school programs are full days (2 workshops per day: 9 am-12 pm and 1 pm – 4 pm) with final performances on June 22nd and 23rd. Middle school programs begin June 12 and meet from 9 am – 12 pm with final performances July 14th and 15th. Counselors are expected to attend each daily workshop and performance for the session to which they have been assigned. The High School program will meet M-F from 5-9pm. Workshops begin June 19th with performances on July 27th, 28th, and 29th.
